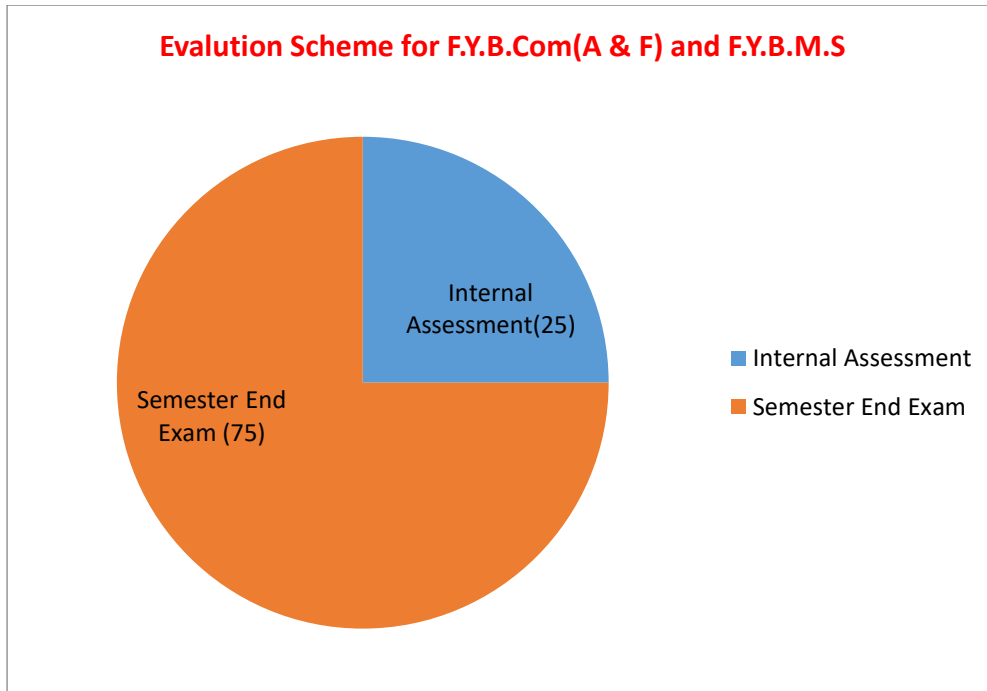
Scheme of Examination :

The performance of professional course B.Com (A &F) and BMS learners will be evaluated in two Components. One component will be continuous Internal Assessment carrying 25% marks and the second component will be Semester End Examination carrying 75% marks.

For **Traditional Course (B.Com)** learners will be evaluated on the basis of Semester End Examination carrying **100%** marks except Foundation Course.

The allocation of marks for the Internal Assessment and Semester End Examinations will be as shown below:-

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Passing Standard:

For passing a programme, learner shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% of marks in aggregate for each course where the course consists of Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination. The learners shall have to obtain a minimum of 40% marks in the Internal Assessment (i.e. 10 out of 25) and 40% marks in Semester End Examination (i.e. 30 Out of 75 & 40 Out of 100) separately, to pass the course and minimum of Grade D to pass a particular semester. A learner will pass the programme if he/she passes the continues Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination together.

Scheme of Examination :

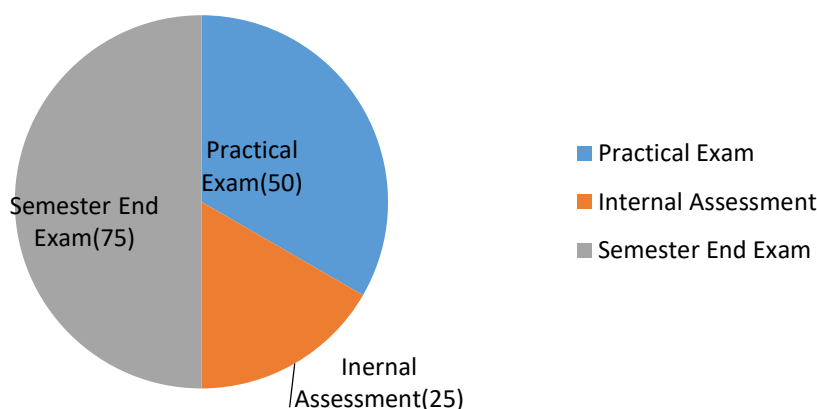
The performance of the learners will be evaluated into two components for specialty programmes like B.Sc.(IT), B.Sc.(CS) . The learner's Performance will be assessed by Internal Assessment with 25% marks in the first component by conducting the Semester End Examinations with 75% marks in the second component.

For **Traditional Course (B.Sc.)** learners will be evaluated on the basis of Semester End Examination carrying **100%** marks except Foundation Course.
